January's event is going to be our Annual General Meeting and it goes without saying that we hope to see you there!



LIBRARY BOOK OF THE MONTH



As kids we used to lie on the grass and cloud-watch. We usually found animals or people we knew with distinctive features or clothing. "Look, I see an elephant.... see his long trunk? Or "there is Mrs. Paul wearing her big black hat to church". Even now on a road trip we see pictures and weather predictions in the clouds: and who doesn't t marvel at a gorgeous sky-show?

As artists we try to create our sense or feelings about the immensity of skies and variety and nuance of clouds. There s a valuable reference book in our BAA library by William F Powell, a Walter Foster book, titled simply "Clouds and Skies" in which he studies cloud types, how to plan colours, depicting mood and creating dramatic skies. It is worth a look.
